

### Terms and Conditions for General Admission Season Tickets

- Tickets and parking passes are licenses and may be revoked at any time for any reason. Renewal of ticket and parking privileges is at the sole discretion of the Washington Redskins. Parking permits must be displayed at all times. One permit = one parking space. Vehicles parked without a visible parking permit, parked in fire lanes, parked in no parking zones, double parked, abandoned, or improperly parked in handicapped parking spaces will be towed at owner's risk and expense. Tailgaters must comply with stadium regulations.
- Season Ticket packages may not be advertised or resold at any price. Resale of individual tickets for individual games is prohibited, except to the extent permitted through the Washington Redskins' authorized fan-to-fan ticket marketplace. Resale is not permitted on stadium grounds and may result in confiscation of tickets, refusal of entry into the stadium, fine and/or arrest. Violation of these restrictions results in automatic termination of this license.
- The Redskins are committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for all fans, both in the stadium and in the parking lot. We want all fans attending our games to enjoy the experience in a responsible fashion. When attending games, you are required to refrain from the following behavior:
  - Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, or illegal.
  - Intoxication or other signs of alcohol impairment.
  - Foul or offensive language or obscene gestures.
  - Interference with the progress of the game (including throwing objects onto the field).
  - Failure to follow instructions of stadium personnel.
  - Verbal or physical harassment of others, including fans of the opposing team.
  - Transporting or assisting in the transport of prohibited items into the stadium.

Event patrons are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their guests and/or persons occupying their seats. Stadium staff will intervene to support an environment where event patrons, their guests, and other fans can enjoy the event free from the above behavior. Event patrons and guests who violate these provisions will be subject to ejection without refund and potential loss of ticket privileges for future games.

- Date and time of games are subject to change. Tickets and parking passes may not be refunded or exchanged for any reason, including the change of day or time of the game. Once a game has commenced, there will be no refund or exchange for tickets or parking passes in the event the game is terminated prior to its standard conclusion. Counterfeit, stolen, or incorrect event tickets and parking passes will not be honored. A full, unused ticket must be presented for admission to FedExField. Tickets missing a barcode are invalid and will not be accepted for admission. Tickets with barcodes that have already been scanned are not valid for admission to that event.
- The Washington Redskins will not replace lost, stolen, or destroyed tickets, parking passes, guest passes or hospitality credentials (e.g., Touchdown Club credentials, Hall of Fame Plaza credentials, Ultimate Fan Zone wristbands, Loge Buffet wristbands) except in accordance with the replacement policy set forth at [www.redskins.com](http://www.redskins.com).
- As a condition of admission to FedExField, users of Redskins tickets consent to a physical search for items that are prohibited from FedExField, including but not limited to: bottles, cans, coolers of any size or any other container; umbrellas; animals (except certified service animals); folding chairs; illegal drugs; weapons of any kind; food or drink, including alcoholic beverages; bags, including backpacks, gym bags, duffel bags, packages, briefcases, and large purses. Small purses under 4" in width, 12" in length, and 10" in height are permitted. By tendering a game ticket and entering FedExField, you consent to search and waive any related claims that you might have against the Washington Redskins, the NFL, other NFL member clubs, their affiliates, or their agents. If you elect not to consent to a search, you will be denied entry into the stadium.
- Checks returned for insufficient funds are subject to a \$50.00 fee.
- Payment of invoice and/or use of ticket(s) constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions, as well as the terms and conditions listed at [www.redskins.com](http://www.redskins.com).
- This season ticket agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Maryland. Any dispute arising hereunder shall be heard and determined in the Maryland state or federal courts situated in Prince George's County, Maryland, and both you and the Redskins irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of such courts in any such dispute and **hereby waive the right to trial by jury**. As a condition of your purchase of Redskins season tickets, you agree that any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this season ticket agreement must be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action.
- In the event ticket(s) or parking pass(es) were licensed under separate contract, the terms of such contract control with respect to conflicting terms.
